

Policy for the Boston Post Cane

Whereas: The Town of Roxbury honors one of Eldest members of our community by recognizing them with the Boston Cane award. The nominee has to be a resident of Town of Roxbury minimum of 5years also 90+ years young. Nominations must be submitted and reviewed by Board of Selectmen.

Were as: The person that is submitting the nomination will need to enclose valid identification and proof of residency along with the nomination form. All nominations must be received 60 days from the date of the posting of the notice. The nomination may come from family and friends.

Were as: The recipient will retain this honor as long as he /she lives even though other resident might become eligible. The Town Clerk must be notified if the recipient of the Boston Cane passes or otherwise refuses or returns the honor or moves out of Roxbury, other than to a nursing facility.

Were as: At that time the Town Clerk shall determine the next eldest resident of Roxbury, Maine and present the name to the Board of Selectmen.

Were as: The Roxbury Board of Selectmen or his/hers designee shall present Roxbury's eldest resident with a plaque certificate signifying the honor. The location of the presentation will be determined according to the circumstances of the honoree.
